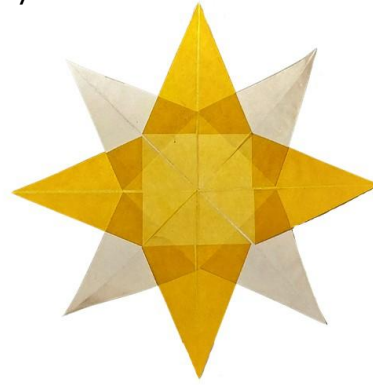




Window Stars Skills Class with Elizabeth Seward Supply List



Materials

- Kite Paper* – squares 6" x 6" (15cm x 15cm) or 3" x 3" (7.5cm x 7.5cm)

Note: I have the standard squares cut professionally in a print store. Precision is important here!

- Bone folder (if you have one – oftentimes used in bookbinding) otherwise, the handle of scissors will work.
- Glue stick
- Slightly padded surface to fold on (such as a magazine)

Notes on Materials

*Kite paper, also known as Seidenpapier, is the best option. STURDY tissue paper may be substituted if necessary.

Kite paper can be found online at Waldorf supply stores, art stores, or on Amazon.com

Preparations to have completed before the class

1. You can make a choice between multiple colors, bright colors, light colors. The beauty of transparent stars is seeing the "inner" pattern revealed when light shines through them. I recommend light colors so the beautiful geometry can be appreciated.
2. We will make 3-6 stars together. You will need 8 squares per star. Allow a couple of extras for wastage.
3. Have this 5 star template printed out.
